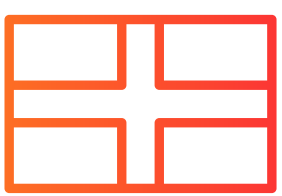

Go to your lodge whenever you want, even at the last minute.

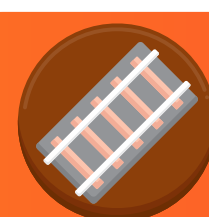
Holiday Homes Have Been Around for Decades

Rain doesn't stop lodge holidays.



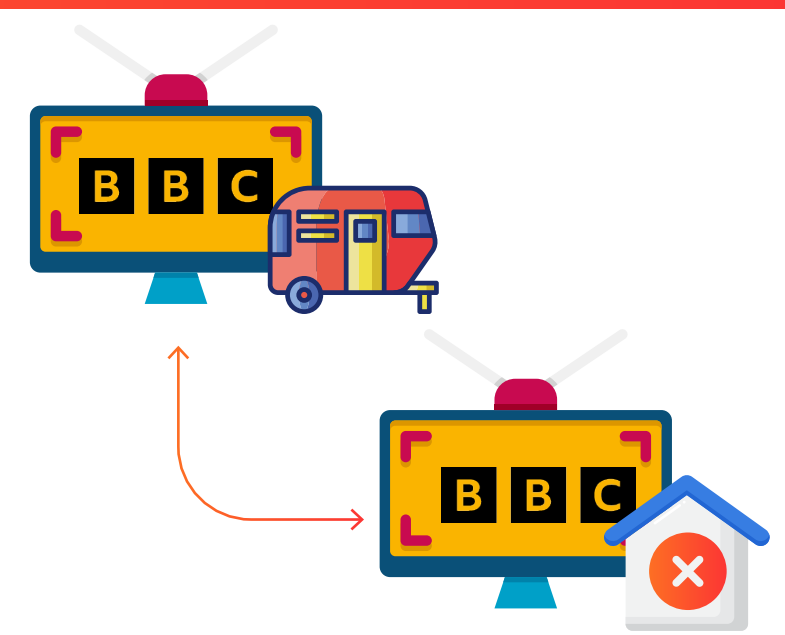
Options include relaxing with a book, exploring local attractions, or family games.
